CITY	COUNTRY
<b>1. People</b>	
crowds, noise, traffic jams, population	peace and quiet, few inhabitants, no privacy
<b>2. Living conditions</b>	
blocks of flats, sky-scrapers, modern conveniences: central heating, mains, gas, private houses	cottages, huts, cesspits, barns, cowsheds, stables, pigsties, hen houses, private houses
<b>3. Employment</b>	
offices, factories, mines, power-stations, chemical plants, glassworks, companies/firms, public institutions, libraries/schools, hospitals, police stations, fire brigade (station), town/city council/office, services	unemployment, work in the field, plough, sow, plant, grow, water, fertilize, weed, harvest, crops (hay)
<b>4. Entertainments</b>	
easy access to theatres, cinemas, Philharmonic Halls, Opera Houses, museums, art galleries, discos, pubs/restaurants, swimming pools, sports stadiums	fresh air, lakes, seaside/beach, forests/woods, rivers, beautiful landscapes, meadows, mountains, horse studs
<b>5. Communication</b>	
bus terminals, railway station, airports, trams, trolleybuses	bus, car, on foot, cart
<b>6. Education</b>	
universities, high /grammar schools, technical schools, vocational schools	primary school, secondary school, low level
